Following Williams death on the 29th March 1869, age 82, his eldest son, John (who never married) took over the tenancy of New Inn. He is recorded in trade directories from 1870 to 1883 either as a beer retailer or a victualler. In 1870 he was paying a rent of £1.1s per year. Prior to the tenancy he was employed as a agricultural labourer. On three occasions John had a brush with the law, twice for allowing his cattle to stray onto the highway. Once for theft, for which he was sent for trail at South Molton Quarter Sessions , the outcome is unknown. In 1891. he is recorded as being a road contractor, living with his married sister Elizabeth and her family. Four years later he died age 78 from Broncho-Pneumonia. His mother Eleanor, lived with him until her death in January 1874, age 84.

--Last Friday evening death came to the relief of Mr. Richard Mayne, after an illness of several days. A year or so ago he was ill for a number of months eigh unto death and while apparently recovered from the siege he has been in very poor health and his constitution could not long withstand the last attack
Mr. Mayne was born in Devonshire Eng., Sept. 29 1828, and lacked but a month and a half of being 69 years of age. He came to America in 1854 and remained three months in New York state. The same year he came to Peoria County, Ill. where he lived about three years and in 1857 came to this township where he has since resided. He was married to Miss. Charlotte Scott in 1870, by Rev. John Borland, one of the pioneer preachers of the Methodist church in this part of the state. Mr. Mayne identified himself with the M. E. church in January 1871, under the ministry of Rev. Reger, who was conducting services in Bethel School house. He lived a thoroughly Christian life.
Besides his wife, deceased leaves one brother Robert of this township, and two sisters in England. The funeral was held Sunday in the M. E. church this city, Rev. De laGardie delivering the sermon. The following friends of the deceased were pall bearers: Messieurs Adam Pflieger, Smith Dixon. G.H. Westcott, Robt. Hitch, Ed Hitch, and H.G. McCord

MRS. MAYNE.

Death of Aged Pioneer Lady Occurs Last Friday -Morning.

---Charlotte Scott was born in Scotland April 24 1842. and passed to the other shore last Friday at 9 o'clock from ailments incidental to advanced years. The first twenty seven years of her life was spent in her native land and though she had resided in America for nearly half a century her heart grew warm with the memories of the "land of the bluebell and Heather."

In 1869 Miss. Scott came to this city to make her home with her sister Mrs. John Steinbach and family, but the next year she was married to Richard Mayne who took his bride to the farm where he later died in 1899, and which Mrs. Mayne still owned until the present. After the death of Mr. Mayne the widow purchased the old John Stock brick residence, remaining there all these years. She was a typical Scott lady, an ardent Christian woman, quaint and most interesting in her speech and habits. Her only surviving blood relatives are a niece and three nephews, Mrs. Harry Kreidler of McAllen, Tex. Louis Steinbach of Nebraska, Charles Steinbach of Chicago, and William Steinbach of New York city. Funeral services were held from the Presbyterian church last Saturday after noon at 2:30 o'clock, Rev. S. S. Cryer in charge. Interment was in the city Cemetery.

Comment:

Both Charlotte and her unmarried sister, are buried in the old Mayne plot in Evergreen Cemetery one half mile east of El Paso Ill.. The head stone of Charlotte Scott Mayne is unique in the area as it is of red granite. Next to Charlotte's grave is a grave with a headstone of the same red granite, inscribed: My Sister, Ellen Scott Aug. 25 1835-Feb. 10 1902.

Across the drive and in the center of an old part of the cemetery are stones of the same red granite listing other individuals family name: Scott. Due to the uniqueness of the stone it may be reasonable to say they are related, (i.e. brother). The inscriptions on this stone(s) are: Father; Thomas Scott Nov., 7, 1830- Jan. 9, 1903; Mother: Keziah Clark "his wife" Oct. 23 1831-April 26 1894; Oliver C. ; Nov. 11, 1867- Oct. 15, 1902. listed in 1880 census location, Panola township

Philip John's younger brother was apprenticed to John Scions of Lower-Bone, Meshaw, met his wife Elizabeth Matthews (the daughter of Richard Matthews and Grace Scoins) of Chumleigh, when she was employed as a servant at the New Inn, they married in 1844. Shortly after the birth of their first child Mary Ann (1845), who died when she was 5, they moved to Barton, Ashwater, and then to 2 Quoditch Moor, Ashwater. His cousin John, a shoe maker lived next door. They had six further children, Betsey (1847), Samuel (1849) who, died age 2, William (1851), Richard (1854), Ellen (1857) and Annie (1862). For most

of his working life he was employed as a agricultural labourer, as referred to in the census returns for 1841 to 1881, but in 1891 he is recorded as a marine store dealer. Philip died in January 1899 age 79. Elizabeth had died three weeks earlier also age 79.

Robert Mayne

Resident of This Township and City Nearly Half a Century

--Dies Friday Evening

--Last Friday evening at about 9 o'clock after month of suffering from asthma and complications, Robert Mayne, a pioneer of this community, passed away at his residence on west Main street. His ailment had prevented him from sleeping in his bed for several weeks, being forced to take all his rest while sitting in a chair. For several days he was seen to be failing rapidly although he would not give up entirely. Friday night at the hour above stated, he crossed the room assisted by one of his sons, when suddenly he sank to the floor, expiring immediately.

Robert Mayne was born in Devonshire Eng., July 27 1835. He came to America, arriving in this country on March 24 1854. His first two years were spent in New York and Canada. In the spring of 1856 he moved to Peoria, county, Illinois; where he continued to reside for seven years. He then came to El Paso township and until about eight years ago resided on his farmland southwest of town. In 1904 he and Mrs. Mayne erected a commodious home on west Main street and took up their residence in the city to rest from their long labors on the farm. Mr. Mayne was married to Miss Alice Campbell in the year, 1864. Besides the sorrowing wife the deceased leaves nine children to mourn the taking away of the husband and father. The children are Wilbur, of Newton, Kan.; Thomas C. Chicago; Mrs. Nellie Muller, Peoria; Mrs. Minnie Herr, Zearing, IA.; Mrs. Bettie Burroughs, Panola; Richard and Robert, El Paso; Mrs. Maud Pfleeger and Mrs. Jettie Pfleeger, El Paso. Surviving the deceased, are also two sisters. in England, Mrs. Marry Saxon and Mrs. Lizzie Pike besides twenty six grandchildren.

Mr. Mayne had been a member of the Presbyterian church for about thirty five years, and it was from this church of his choice that the funeral services were held last Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. R. F. Cressey in charge. The service was attended by a large number of the friends and neighbors who had known Mr. Mayne so long and so well. Internment was in the city cemetery. [Evergreen]

DEATH OF PIONEER

Mrs. Elizabeth Mayne Passes to Final Reward Yesterday Morning
Funeral Saturday

--Wednesday morning at 11:30 o'clock another of El Paso's most highly regarded residents joined those in death who with her had taken a prominent part in the early history of the community and since have, passed on.

Elizabeth Alice Campbell was born to Thomas and Betsy Campbell at Blairsville, Pa., February 11, 1841 When she was. 15 years of age she came with her parents to Illinois, the trip being by boat down the Ohio river.,and, up the Mississippi to Knox county where the family resided for several years, then moving to Woodford county to the farm southwest of El Paso now owned by Charles Grieser. The Campbell home early served a distributing post for the mail routs when all mail was carried overland on, horse back in saddlebags. It is stated that Elizabeth frequently assisted the mail carriers, by helping them to dismount when their clothing was actually frozen to their saddles.

Helpful, kindly, ever. forgetful of self, in the welfare of others, she will indeed be missed while a shut in for the past twenty years Mrs. Mayne was a daily reader of her newspaper and kept fully informed on. the. world's activities. Her dominant will permitted her to care for, her physical wants, at times when-her children hardly understood how she could do so. Mrs. Mayne suffered a fall last July 4 from which she never fully recovered, until finally her aged body with complications broke, although she never seemed to lose her sweet tempered character and her passing was peaceful and came without murmur. She recognized. her-relatives and other visitors until three hours of her demise. Funeral, services will be held from Presbyterian church next Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, Rev. G. J. MAYNE FAMILY HISTORY

(From the Devon Area of England)

By: C. Nick Mayne

May 24, 1999

From all the Parish records so far checked it appears that the earliest branch of "OUR LINE" of Maynes are from the Parish of Winkleigh, in the County of Devon.

The earliest records for Winkleigh are the Churchwardens accounts which commence in 1512, which are written in either Old English or Latin, and are extremely difficult to read. During the reign of Henry VIII in 1519, John Mayne is recorded as a Churchwarden receiving goods on behalf of the Church, later the same year he receives payment for work done by himself for the Church. Thomas Mayne, appears in 1531, also as a Churchwarden, and later in the reign of Elizabeth I, in 1567, Johannes Mayne is distributing money to the poor of the village from Church funds.

The parish registers commence for baptisms in 1585, marriages and burials in 1569. The earliest Maynes recorded were baptisms 1603, marriages 1570 and burials 1575.

For the early years the details of "OUR TREE" is only as accurate as the information available.

Johannis Meane is at the head of the "TREE", first recorded on the 25 November 1600, being married to Scipio Luxton at Winkleigh. They had six children, Pentrus (1603), Thomas (1605), Johannes (1610), Barnabrus (1613), Maria (1615), and Jona (1618), Johannis was buried on the 2nd January 1624.

Thomas his second son was baptised 23rd February 1605, again there is no information on his marriage. In 1641, he signed the "Protestation Oath", a declaration of belief in the Protestant Religion, Allegiance to the King and support for the Rights and Privileges of Parliament. Before he died in 1658 he had three sons, John, George and Thomas.

John, his eldest son, married Margery Heddon on the 25th February 1656, they had four sons: Thomas (1657), who married and became a Curate, John (1660), George (1666) and Michael (1664). John was buried 20th March 1656 and Margery was buried on 25th December 1701.

George was baptised 24th March 1666, again we do not know who his wife was, but they had eight children, Anna (1692), Johan (1694), Mary (1701), who married John Tawton, Richard (1703) who married Mary Short, Thomas (1706), Margery (1709-died 1712), and Margery (1713) who married John Evens.

Thomas Mayne was baptised at Winkleigh on the 4th March 1706, married Grace, and had five children, Michael (1729), Joan (1731), John (1734), Anne (1735) and Thomas (1737), they were all baptised at Winkleigh.

Michael who was baptised on the 12th July 1729, married Mary Handford on the 11th February 1753 at Eggesford Church. They had four children, John (1757) who married Ann Underhill in 1789, Philip (1759), who married Elizabeth Smale (the daughter of John Smale and Mary Lee) on the 11th October 1785 at Morchard Bishop, Ann (1764) and Thomas (1753) who married Mary Cole in 1781. Michael was buried 28th October 1770 at Wembworthy.

William son of Philip and Elizabaeth, was baptised in the Parish Church of ST. Michael and All Angels, Wembworthy, on the 3rd September 1786. William was the eldest of the seven children of Philip and Elizabeth. John (1790 - died 1791), John (1792 - died 1792), Daniel (1793) Mary (1796), Elizabeth (1797 - died 1801) and Elizabeth (1806).

In March 1815 William married Eleanor Collins (daughter of Samuel Collins and Anne Jefford) from the Parish of Musbury and the Parish of Meshaw. How they met is a mystery as the two Parishes are approximately 40 miles apart.

They had ten children, John (1815), William (1818), Philip (1820), Samuel (1823), Ann (1825), Richard (1827), Eleanor (1829), Elizabeth (1831), Robert (1834), and Mary (1837). They were all baptised in Meshaw Parish Church. Richard and Robert both migrated to America in 1854. William is well documented, on the 1838 title map, he is shown as renting a cottage plus 1-1/2 acres. Various trade

directories between 1850 and 1866 record him as a victualler, of New Inn, Meshaw. the Census returns of 1841, 51 and 61 confirm he was a publican. All their children were well educated as they were all able to sign the church registers when they married.

Following Willams death on the 29th March 1869, age 82, his eldest son John (who never married) took over the tenancy of New Inn. He is recorded in trades directories from 1870 to 1883 either as a beer retailer or a victualer. In 1870 he was paying a rent of f1.1s per year. Prior to the tenancy he was employed as a agricultural labourer. On three occasions John had a brush with the law, twice for allowing his cattle to stray onto the highway. Once for theft, for which he was sent for trial at Sough Malton Quarter Session. The outcome is unknown. In 1891, he is recorded as being a road contractor, living with his married sister Elizabeth and her family. Four years later he died, age 78, from Broncho-Pneumonia. His mother, Elanor, lived with him until her death in January 1874, age 84.

Philip, his younger brother was apprenticed to John Scions of Lower-Bone, Meshaw, met his wife Elizabeth Mattherws (daughter of Richard Matthews and Grace Scoins) of Chumleigh, when she was employed as a servant at the New Inn. They married in 1844. Shortly after the birth of their first child, Mary Ann (1845), who died when she was 5, they moved to Barton, Ashwater, and then to 2 Quoditch Moor, Ashwater. His cousin John, a shoe maker lived next door. They had six further children, Betsey (1847), Samuel (1849)who died at age 2, William (1851), Richard (1854), Ellen (1857) and Annie (1862). For most of his working life he was employed as a agricultural labourer, as referred to in the census returns of 1841 to 1881, but in 1891 he is recored as a marine store dealer. Philip died in January 1899 at age 79. Elizabeth had died three weeks earlier also age 79.

William, his second son, married Mary Jane Wonnacott (daughter of George Wonnacott and Mary Hern) in December 1870, at Holsworthy Register Office, when they were both age 19. They had ten children, three girs and seven boys. Willam became a tenant farmer at Raxon Cross, Broadwoodwidge, from 1919 until his death in December 1928, then age 77. Six month later the farm of 23 acres was put up for sale in auction with a reserve price of f750. Mary Ann died 30th December 1933. They are burried together at Broadwoodwidge.

William's second son, Charles, was born May 1876 at North Tamerton, Cornwall. He later married Ellen Colwill (daughter of Wiliam Colwill and Harriet Pearse) from Lewannick, on the 27th March 1901 at Launceston Register Office. Charles spent his entire working life working for the Cooke-Hurle family, who owned land in both Devon and somerset. Charles travelled between the two estates, buried in Holne Parish Churchyard. They were married for 41 years and had six children, Mary Ellen (1906), Willam Charles (1906 and died an infant), Caroline Elizabeth (1909), Violet E. (1915), Charlie (1916 and william John (1919) (NOTE: Charlie (1916) is the father of the author - C. Nick Mayne).

The two brothers, Richard and Robert who migrated, arrived in New York on the 24th of March 1854. After arriving, stayed in New York for three months, then moved to Canada for two years, before moving to Peoria, Illinois, where they lived for seven years. In 1863 they moved to El Paso, Illinois. It was there that the two brothers settled and married. They both bought land from the Railroad Company and farmed it until their retirement.

Robert married Elizabeth Alice Campbell, whose ancesters left Scotland after the Stuart Rebellion, her elder brother Charles became a General with the Union Army in the civil war. Robert and Elizabeth, had nine children, Wilber (1862), Nellie (1868), Thomas (1870), Bettie (1971), Richard (1874), Minnie (1876), Robert(1881), Georgetta (1884) and Maude (1889). A number of their desendants are still living in America.

Richard married Charlotte Scott and had no children. Richard died 13th August 1897, and Robert 17th May 1912. They are both buried in "Evergreen" cemetary, El Paso, Woodford County Illinois.

NOTE: Since Nick wrote this in 1999, I have talked with a decendant of Robert and Elizabeth. There are two (2) remaining cousins from this line and they will be the last Maynes from the union of Robert and Elizabeth as they both have only had daughters, who when they marry will change their names as is true with tradition.

An addendum to the work of C. Nick Mayne ---- by Steven G. Mayne Sr.--- Joseph Mayne (Joseph,John,Michael,Thomas,George,John,Thomas Meane) was born in Chumligh in 1828 and married Arabella Broadmead, who was also born in Chumleigh. Joseph was listed in the 1851 census as age 23 and a farm labourer at the Ford Farm in Chumleigh. They had 3 children: Richard (1855), John (1853) and Francis (Fanny) (1861) all born in Chumleigh, Devon. Richard is said to have had 2 children, but it is unknown to whom he was married or who the children were at this time. Francis (Fanny) Mayne is said to have also married and had 3 children, and is also unknown to whom she was married or the names of the Children. On the other hand John Mayne(1853) had 14 children.

John Mayne was born 21 April 1853 in Chumleigh. He married Pheobe Hall (daughter of Henry Hall and Lydia Bennet) 10th September 1873 in Corfu, New York. John and Pheobe had 14 children: Lydia Ann (1873), Frank Henry(1875), Clara Arabella (1877),Bertha Edyth (1882) Grover John (1884),Richard Arthur(1886), Edna May (1888), Raymond Ernest (1890), Joseph Hall (1892),Eva

Melvina (1894) Getrude Elizabeth (1896), George William (1898), Robert Newell (1900), and Lyle Kenneth (1902). John came to New York when he was about 12 years old, by unknown means. He was a section forman on the New York Central at Corfu, New York for 46 years, retiring May 1, 1923. He died 16 April, 1926 in Corfu. George William (1898) was my Grandfather.
